Workload requirements (Minimum credits to be registered)	Exchange students are required to take a minimum workload of 20 hours (1200 minutes) per week. (2-24, 3-20, 4-16)  Since one class takes 120 minutes, exchange students should register 6 (for 2 <sup>nd</sup> courses) 5(for 3 <sup>rd</sup> courses) 4(for 4 <sup>th</sup> courses) or more per week to fulfill the requirement.

Expected graduation/completion date at home university 5. Intended student status at TSUL (Exchange Student or Special Research Student) 6. Intended period of exchange
